American troops murdered Japanese POWs according to one of the most detailed studies of memoirs of the Second World War in the Pacific published this week: Hara Kiri and Kamikaze. The Pacific War continued on for three more years. Genda served with distinction during World War II and personally participated in it, but he was a noted naval aviator and fighter pilot with over 3,000 flight hours. He organized an elite Japanese air unit, the 343rd Kōkūtai, near the war's end as an alternative to the suicidal kamikaze units. The historic battle included the largest onslaught of the war by suicidal kamikaze pilots. It was at Okinawa that the Navy suffered its heaviest losses in ships and manpower during World War II. Miraculously, all the crew survived, with two shipmates receiving the Purple Heart as a result of kamikaze attacks. On the cover, Kamikaze Watercolor by artist Dwight Shepler depicts an unsuccessful suicide attack by a Japanese Zero fighter on the aircraft carrier USS Hornet (CV-12) on 18 March 1945. Hornet was operating at the time as part of Task Force 58, launching strikes against the Japanese home island of Kyushu.
