Whiteread whose mother was also an artist grew up in ilford and essex she knew from an early age that she wanted to make art and she attended brighton polytechnic 1982 85 where she studied painting and the slade school of fine art 1985 87 where she studied sculpture for her first solo exhibition 1988 at the now defunct carlisle gallery in islington she showed four sculptures.
