The shin hanga movement literally meaning new prints was an art movement in the early part of the 20th century in japan during the taisho 1912 1925 and showa 1926 1989 periods with its peak between 1920 and 1950

Kawase hasui 1883 1957 was one of the first artists associated with the shin hanga literally new print movement that arose in the 1920s shin hanga artists specialized in nostalgic romanticized views of japan which were produced using the time honored system of enlisting the aid of a publisher woodblock carvers and highly skilled printers. This print was groundbreaking in japan being the first abstract work and that firmly connected the s?saku hanga movement to the modern avant garde this early print bined printing from both carved sides of the block in order to create the unfolding shape which opens anically from overlying curves of red outlined in flaring lines of white and red tones. After the meiji era the traditional japanese co operation of four different professionals producing woodblock prints were called the shin hanga literally meaning new prints movement in the 20 th century publisher

watanabe sh?zabur? who was responsible for publishing the prints designed by kawase hasui and it? shinsui for example was instrumental in reviving this tradition of producing.

Shin hanga translated to be new print movement was closely tied to the traditional woodblock printing form of ukiyo e prints ukiyo e which means pictures of the floating world was a form of escapism for the edo period 1603 1868 middle merchant class

Shin hanga was a japanese art movement that integrated western elements without giving up the old values of japanese traditional woodblock prints instead of blindly imitating western art

styles the new movement concentrated on traditional subjects like landscapes beautiful women and actor portraits. Shin hanga japan s new prints some of japan s most iconic artists emerged from the shin hanga new prints period and their works continue to have a lasting impression on collectors to this day defined by majestic landscapes and elegant depictions of women along with the use of vivid colors and an exceptional attention to detail woodblock prints from the shin hanga period. However with the new century the woodblock print found new life some artists of the shin hanga movement studied as oil painters in the western tradition or nihonga painters and many found.

Watanabe coined the term shin hanga around 1915 and guided the movement but he was not the only publisher of the genre shin hanga new prints are 20th century japanese prints made by the same traditional system used to produce ukiyo e but most shin hanga prints are distinctly different from traditional ukiyo e in their looks western manner and tactile quality of the modern paper and
