At the time there was a tradition of making hanukkah when you shop the largest online selection at ebay related objects like dreidels out of lead so that they could be melted down in the new year hanukkah lamps were usually made of sturdier metals however so that they wouldn't be damaged by a candle's flame this hanukkiah gradually melted and warped because it was made of lead

The use of the hanukkah lamp in the home is mentioned in the talmudic period but not physical examples of such lamps have been found from before the 15th century from as least the 11th century there is also mention of the use of the hanukkah lamp in the synagogue and this use is explained in more detail by Joseph Caro in the 16th century. Hanukkah lamp is a nine branched candelabrum lit during the eight day holiday of hanukkah as opposed to the seven branched menorah used in the ancient temple or as a symbol on each night of hanukkah a new branch is lit. The seven branched menorah has been a traditional symbol of judaism for centuries along with the star of david the lamp is most mostly called a hanukkah menorah or simply menorah for

Name english speakers most monly call the lamp a menorah or hanukkah menorah the hebrew word menorah simply means lamp in modern hebrew the lamp is generally called a chanukkiyah a term coined at the end of the nineteenth century by hemda ben yehuda whose husband eliezer ben yehuda was the leading force behind the revival of the hebrew language

Through the centuries the importance of hanukkah has grown and with it the centrality of the lamp the material that lamps should be made of has also been prescribed by rabbinical authorities in order to fulfill the mandment in as beautiful a way as one could afford using the most precious materials possible ranging from gold and silver.
