She's a fascinating woman. This book is put together in a way very pleasing to the eyes. I read another biography of this amazing woman earlier this year by Sarah B. Pomeroy which I thought was a little bit better. Mostly, I did not like how Sidman instead of just explaining how things were back in Merian's time made judgmental backhanded comments about the time. One of those things that really rubbed me wrong was when she essentially said you've got to excuse Maria for believing in God and mentioning God in her scientific observations because everyone back then believed in God. I think the author should've just stuck to the facts and left her personal opinions about belief in God out of it. Sidman did do a good job of conveying what life was like for a woman in the 17th century and how Maria was so atypical and ahead of her time. So overall a decent and beautiful biography.
