Through fair and meaningful work these women are overing stigma pulling themselves out of poverty and rediscovering their value and worth think about who made your goods when making purchases. The culture of morocco refers to the culture or cultures behaviors customs knowledge beliefs arts laws etc of moroccan society moroccan culture is primarily muslim and it represents a confluence of influences amazigh arab sahwari sub saharan african mediterranean andalusi jewish european and more the majority of morocco s population identifies as berber and arab. One pany is trying to make a dfference the anou is a munity of over 400 artisans who are working to revive the artisan munity in morocco from within by creating equal access to global markets for all artisans the munity is centered upon a mobile based online platform that enables artisans regardless of literacy levels to independently post their work online receive feedback and sell their work directly to customers all over the world.

After breakfast we gathered around the women as they told their stories and answered our eager questions about what it is like being a woman in morocco wonderful breakfast spread prepared for us listening to these women was awesome and enlightening a truly special experience that evoked laughter tears dancing and singing. Women in morocco are stereotypically expected to take care of the home and family engaging in activities such as cooking cleaning shopping weaving caring for the elderly and educating the children while the man is away at work in their free time women meet other societal expectations of visiting family friends and attending evening prayer services at the local mosque or shrine.
