Earthquakes usually occur on the edges of large sections of the earth s crust called tectonic plates these plates slowly move over a long period of time sometimes the edges which are called fault lines can get stuck but the plates keep moving pressure slowly starts to build up where the edges are stuck and once the pressure gets strong. An earthquake is an intense shaking of earth s surface the shaking is caused by movements in earth s outermost layer why do earthquakes happen although the earth looks like a pretty solid place from the surface it s actually extremely active just below the surface. An earthquake also known as a quake tremor or temblor is the shaking of the surface of the earth resulting from a sudden release of energy in the earth s lithosphere that creates seismic waves earthquakes can range in size from those that are so weak that they cannot be felt to those violent enough to propel objects and people into the air and wreak destruction across entire cities. Major earthquakes on average about 1 000 earthquakes with intensities of 5 0 or greater are recorded each year great earthquakes magnitude 8 0 or higher occur once a year major earthquakes magnitude 7 0 7 9 occur 18 times a

year strong earthquakes magnitude 6 0 6 9 10 times a month and moderate earthquakes magnitude 5 0 5 9 more than twice a day.
