When William Malm published his wide-ranging study of traditional Japanese music in 1959, it was the first time in the twentieth century that such a work had been brought out in a Western language. Malm's book has still not been replaced as the single most interesting and authoritative text on the subject, but until now it was never revised or updated, nor were its illustrations ever changed.

Japan's Ministry of Education classifies *hōgaku* as a category separate from other traditional forms of music, such as *gagaku* (court music) or *shōmyō* (Buddhist chanting). But most ethnomusicologists view *hōgaku* in

These four instruments are not just credited with creating traditional Japanese music but can also tell a story about Japanese culture. The *shamisen* has a basic form similar to that of the banjo, with three strings that are plucked with a large pick called a *bachi*. Musical instruments have sung of the spirit of Japan and swayed Japanese hearts for centuries. Japanese wind instruments have a history of more than 1,000 years, while one string instrument was introduced only in the 1800s. They have all helped to create the color of Japanese music, evolving in tune with traditional performing arts. Japanese music is extremely diverse: solo music, chamber music, court music, festival and folk music, different types of theatre music, percussion music, epic singing, and many more. This article presents a general overview of Japanese traditional solo and how it evolved into ensemble music.

Different from Western music, Japanese music flows in an attempt to reflect the feeling of nature. The tempo usually starts out very slow and gets faster, returns to being slow again, and has a drawn-out ending. Traditional Japanese music is influenced by Chinese music because some of the musical instruments used in it came from China.

That said, Japanese people tend to be more familiar with Western music than traditional Japanese music, so conventional instruments used to play Western-style music could be a hook for creating interest in traditional music fusion with the West, and future innovations could be standard or even traditional 400 years from now. Japan preserves ancient Asian music around the world; the *koto* and *shakuhachi* are known as typical Japanese instruments, and the theatrical forms of classical *noh*, *kabuki*, and the *bunraku* puppet theater all forms where music plays a very important part, have international fame as well. Dubbed a Japanese harp, the *koto*'s lyrical sound mixes well with the *shamisen*, *shakuhachi*, and percussion to help with the sounds of *bunraku* or *kabuki*. The *biwa*, a four-stringed lute with a rounded body, is the favorite instrument of the goddess of music and poetry, *Benzaiten*.
